



Group Tour & Tasting Policy

Space is limited at our facility and in order to ensure a wonderful wine tasting experience for all guests and visitors to our winery we ask that you abide by our group tour policy.

- A group consists of 10 or more guests arriving to the winery together to participate in a tasting with the option of touring the facility.
- Subject to availability, group tastings are accommodated between the hours of **11am and 2pm only**, seven days a week from Memorial Day until November 30 (11:00-3:30 pm March-May) Reservations **MUST** be scheduled two weeks in advance.
- Groups of 20 people or more arriving at the winery must have a scheduled, prepaid group tasting reservation, with a confirmation number which will be provided by staff during the reservation and payment process.
- A credit card is needed to secure a group reservation. Payments will be processed the week of the reservation date.
- Scheduled groups should arrive at least 10 minutes prior to their scheduled tasting time. In the event that a group is delayed, we will hold the reservation for up to 30 minutes, if the Group Leader has contacted the Tasting Room staff. After 30 minutes the reservation will be subject to cancellation and rescheduling based on the winery's availability.
- Cancellations must be made and confirmed by a winery staff member at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled reservation for a full refund. Cancellations made through voicemail will not be considered advanced notification. If your visit is cancelled due to 'no show' and without notice, your credit card will be charged a **cancellation fee of \$100**.
- Changes to the number of the group must be made in advance (24 hours) to receive a refund for the change in head count.
- Only picnic tables on the vineyard lawn designated area may be reserved for groups between the hours of 11:00am and 2:00pm. Picnic tables located outside

of the Vineyard Grille tent as well as inside the tent cannot be reserved. These tables are strictly on a first come, first served basis and are intended for Vineyard Grille customers.

- Any parties arriving to the winery intoxicated will not be served.
